USING PAYPAL TO RENEW MEMBERSHIP & PURCHASE BOBBINS

You can renew your membership by going to our website: www.Heartlandlace.org. On the home page you will see a "Pay Now" button. You do not have to have a Paypal account to use this feature but will need a credit card. You can pay for as many years ahead as you wish by simply entering the amount you want to pay. Each transaction costs \$.56 (or \$.65 for foreign addresses) so paying for several years at a time is good for the guild. If you want to buy a year bobbin, simply add it's cost to the total amount. Deadline for renewal each year is JAN. 5.



Please, as a courtesy to the designers, do not copy the original pattern in this newsletter for others. Please, no reprinting in other newsletters. We will be happy to share on request when possible.

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Fill shuttle & leave ball thread attached. We only cut threads once in this pattern and that's at the very end. R 4-4-4 T. Ch 20 T. R 4+4+4-4 (join to last p of PR, join to 2nd p of PR) T. Ch 8 T. * R 4+4-4-4 (join to last p of PR) T. Ch 8 T. Rep from * 4 times. % R 4+4-4-4 (join to last p of PR) T. Ch 9 T. Rep from % 5 times. @ R 4+4-4-4 (join to last p of PR). Rep from @ twice to form the 3 ring cloverleaf at the center top of heart. # Ch 9 T. R 4+4-4-4 (join to last p of PR). Rep from # 4 times. Ch 8 T. R 4+4-4-4 (join to last p of PR). Rep from # 3 times. Ch 8 T. R 4+4-4+4 (join to last p of PR, join to 1st p of 1st R made - make sure there are no twists in the work before joining) T. Ch 8 join to base of 1st R made. Do NOT cut threads. The next two rows will be worked in Chains only. Starting at the bottom of heart - Ch 24. Join at the base of the next ring. Working around, make first 6 Ch's with 10 ds in each Ch. The next 4 Ch's have 12 ds in each chain. The next Ch is the center top - Ch 10 ds, skip the base of the cloverleaf and join at the base of the next R. Next 4 Ch are 12 ds and the rest have 10 ds. The next row is the final row with picots. 1st Ch at bottom of heart is 2 ds, 15 p sep by 2ds, 2ds. Join to the base of the next R. Next 6 Chs are 2ds, 6 p sep by 2ds, 2ds. Next 4 Chs are made with 7 p's. The top center Ch has 3 p's. The next 4 Ch's have 7 p's and the rest are 6 p's. Cut and tie off threads.
